Subject: GRADUATION CEREMONY 1987

All staff members have been accordingly invited by the Rector to the graduation ceremony and to the buffet-lunch on 7 December 1987 in the City Hall of Malmö. To facilitate the preparations of the ceremony staff members are reminded to soonest inform KNN on the number of guests they will invite (limited to spouse and two other family members).

Staff with official functions at the ceremony (see attached list) is required to be at the City Hall at 0845 on 7 December. Staff without official functions and all invited family members are required to be in the Hall at latest 0930. Staff members without official functions but participating in the academic procession should be in the Hall at latest 0915.

Staff with official functions is invited to attend a meeting on Tuesday 1 December at 1500 hours in Conference Room 1. Other staff which have not attended any Graduation Ceremony is also invited. During the meeting the Rector, Grand Marshal and the Administrator will go through the procedures and indicate the responsibilities and tasks given to each staff member. On Monday 30 November the Graduation Procedure document will be distributed to the staff concerned.

All staff with official functions including staff participating in the academic procession is required to attend the rehearsal in the City Hall of Malmö on Saturday 5 December commencing at 1300. The rehearsal will last for approx two hours. The rehearsal will also be attended by fourteen ushers from the 1988 class. During the rehearsal each staff participating in the academic procession will be given his/her gown and hood. It is the responsibility of the staff to iron the gown and hood and bring it to the ceremony.

During the ceremony of 1986 there were a few disturbances among the guests; specifically related to photographing. Guests did not only stand up i their seats to take photos preventing other guests to follow the ceremony but also moved around in the Hall during the Ceremony. To reduce the disturbances this year it has been decided to allow photographing only from the seats and to arrange for two professional photographers to take two photos of each hand over of the certificates. (No official videorecording will take place). Children are welcome to attend the ceremony but staff and their family members are asked to take such actions as to avoid children to run around in the Hall during the ceremony.
